Australian Baritone Brett Carter studied Classical Guitar and Voice at the Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts before becoming a member of the Australian Opera Studio. After receiving Scholarships at the National Academy of Music in Melbourne, the Cincinnati Music Festival in Lucca, the Young Artist Program with Opera Queensland, he then received first prize in the German Australian Opera Grant and from 2008 - 2014 was a member of the Hessischen Staatstheater in Wiesbaden.

His roles with included Mozart's **Papageno**, **Guglielmo** the company and **Masetto**, Rossinis Figaro, Donizettis Malatesta, Puccini's Schaunard and Ping, Strauss' Falke and Harlekin, Kurt Weills Bill (Aufstieg und Fall der Stadt Mahagonny), Monteverdis Ulisse (Il ritorno d'Ulisse in patria), Cavallis Mercurio (La Calisto) and Ravels Ramiro (L'Heure Espagnole). During this time he was also engaged at Staatsoper Stuttgart, Oper Frankfurt, the National Theatre Mannheim and Melbourne Opera.

Since the 2014/15 season, Brett Carter is a member of the Staatstheater in Mainz. There his roles have include **Figaro** (Il Barbiere di Sivigilia), **Alloro** (Perelà), **Valentin** (Faust), the **Baritone** in Carmina Burana, **Marcello** (La Bohème), **Il Conte Almaviva** (Le nozze di Figaro), **Rodrigo** (Don Carlo), **Pavel** in Al gran sole calico d'amore, **Silvio** in Pagilacci, **Ottokar** in Der Freischütz, **Demetrius** (A Midsummer Nights Dream), **Leander** (Die Liebe zu den drei Orangen), **Escamillo** (Carmen), **Faninal** (Der Rosenkavalier), **Der Vater** in Hänsel und Gretel, **William** in The Fall of the House of Usher, and the title role as **Nabucco** in Nabucco. Highlights have include his creation of the role of **Odysseus** in the world Premier of Argo for the Schwetzingen Music Festival in 2018 and his interpretation of **Tadeusz** in the co-production of Die Passagierin with Oper Graz.

In the following Season 2025/2026 Brett will make his role debüts as **Frank/Fritz** in die tote Stadt, **the Kaiser** from the Kaiser von Atlantis, **Jen** in Breaking the Waves and **Ford** in Falstaff at the Staatstheater Mainz.
